

How to convert DVD to Sansa, convert video to Sansa player

This is the step by step user guide that shows you how to rip DVD movies and TV shows to SanDisk Sansa video/audio format, convert video files from various sources to SanDisk Sansa video/audio format and download and convert YouTube videos to Sansa video/audio format so that you can watch DVD movies and TV shows, video files and YouTube video on your Sansa player.

Here are the media formats SanDisk Sansa supports: MP3, OGG, FLAC, WMA, secure WMA, WAV, Audible, MPEG4

You will need [Clone2Go DVD Ripper](http://www.clone2go.com), which can be downloaded from <http://www.clone2go.com>. Below is the screenshot of Clone2Go DVD Ripper:



Below are the detailed steps about how to rip DVD movies and convert video files to Sansa using Clone2Go DVD Ripper:

Step 1. Import DVD movies and video files

Insert the DVD disc into the disc drive, click the "Open DVD" button to import it if you are going to watch a DVD movie on your Sansa. Or if the DVD movie is saved as a folder on your computer, you need to click the "Add Video" button to locate that folder, which is composed of two separate folders: VIDEO_TS and AUDIO_TS. From the VIDEO_TS folder, select the .vob file to import and then click "OK".

You can also import video files stored on your PC by clicking the "Add Video" button. The supporting formats are shown as follows:

Audio Files (*.mp2, *.mp3, *.wav)

Windows Media Files (*.avi, *.wmv, *.asf, *.dvr-ms, *.ms-dvr)

MOV/MP4 Files (*.mov, *.mp4, *.3gp, *.m4v, *.qt)

Real Media Files (*.rm, *.rmvb)

Flash Video Files (*.flv)

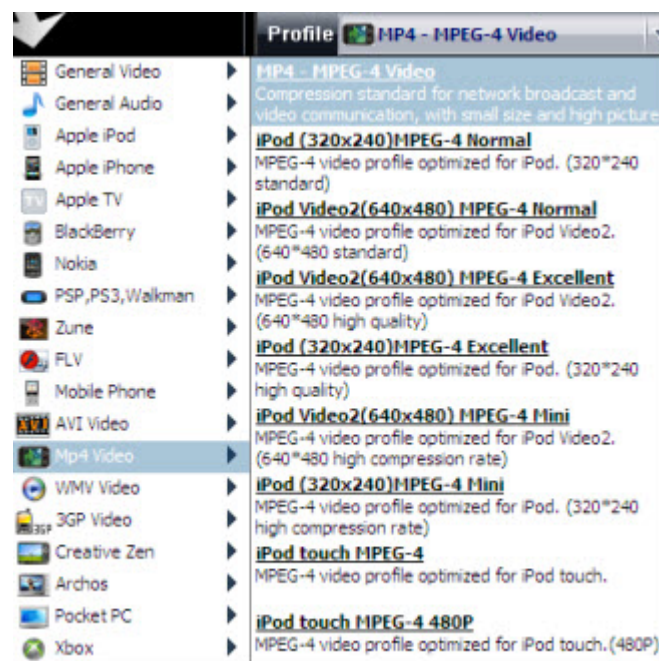
MKV Video Files (*.mkv)

AviSynth Scripts (*.avs)

Other Video Files (*.mpg, *.vob, *.dv, *.m1v, *.m2v, *.dat, *.amv)

Step 2. Choose the output format

From the drop-down list of "Profile", navigate to the "MP4 Video" category. From the sub-category, you can choose the most appropriate output format.



Note: From the profile graph above, we can learn Clone2Go [DVD Ripper](#) also applies to ripping DVD movies and converting video to video/audio formats for iPod, iPhone, PSP, Zune, BlackBerry, Nokia, Creative Zen, etc. Here is the full tutorial: [How to rip DVD to AVI WMV 3GP MP4 FLV SWF MPG MOV video?](#)

Step 3. Start to encode

Now you can click the "Start Encode" button to starting ripping DVD movies and converting videos for your Sansa player.

Note: The output video files are easily available by clicking the "Folder" button on the main menu after the ripping/converting process is done.

Below are several additional tips:

Tip 1. Trim the video

If you only need a certain part of the DVD/video, you can drag the "Start to trim" and "Stop to trim" buttons to get the DVD/video clip after it is imported.

You can also specify the "Start Time" and "Stop time" at the bottom right panel of the interface (under "Profile").

Tip 2. Download YouTube videos

If you want to watch YouTube videos on your Sansa player, you can click the "YouTube" button on the main interface. In the pop-up window, copy and paste the URLs of the YouTube videos one by one.

Tip 3. Customize profile

If you are still not satisfied with the profile you choose, you can customize the parameters such as video codec, video size, video bitrate, video framerate, audio bitrate, audio sample rate, etc.

Tip 4. Batch import and convert DVDs/videos

Clone2Go DVD Ripper allows you to batch import DVD movies and video files and batch convert DVD movies and video files as well.
