

How to Free Download YouTube Videos for iPod/Zune/PSP/BlackBerry

YouTube is one of the most popular websites that offer streaming videos. If you want to watch YouTube videos on your iPod, PSP, Zune, BlackBerry, etc, this tutorial may help you. It is composed of the following two parts:

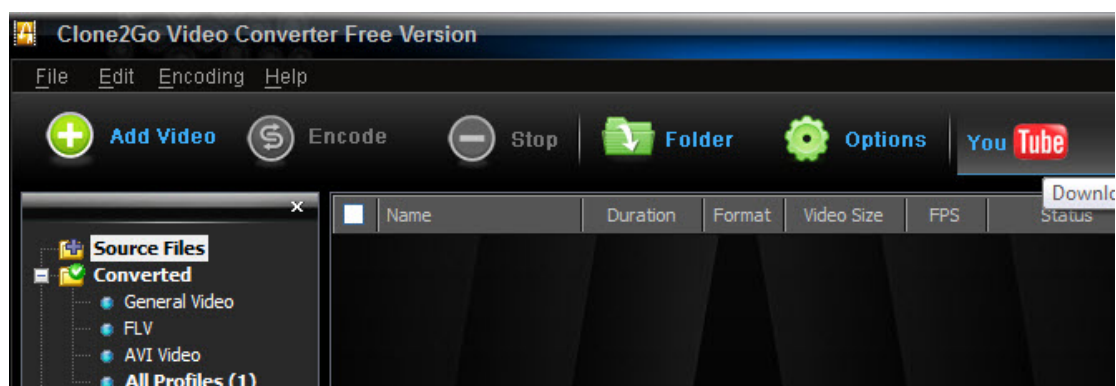
Part 1. How to free download videos from YouTube

In order to download videos from video streaming websites like YouTube, you need a third party program to help you. I'd suggest using Clone2Go Free YouTube Downloader.

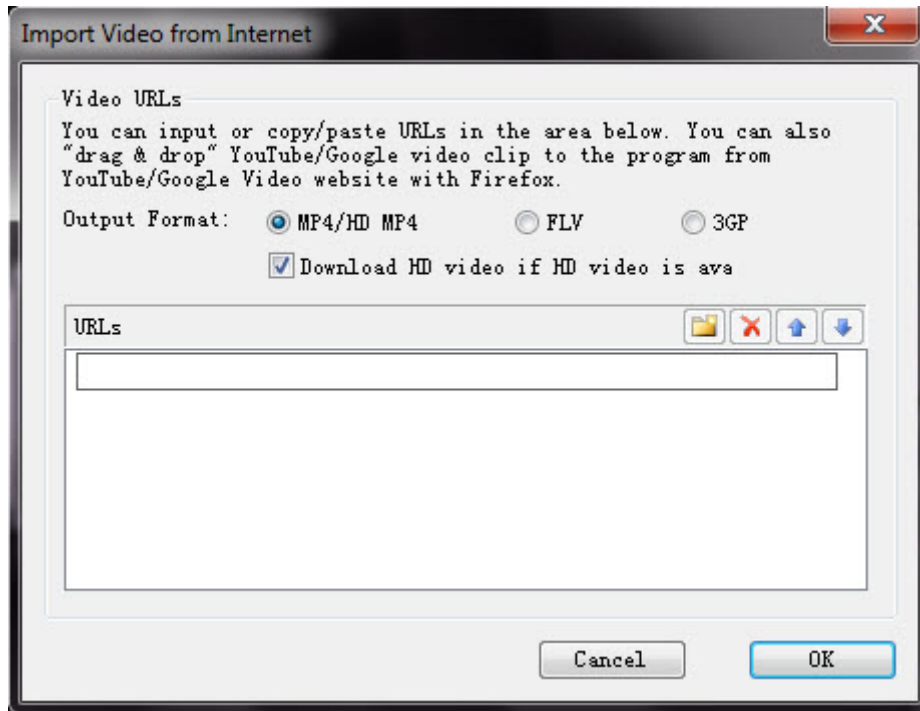
It works great for batch downloading YouTube videos. Let's take a look at how it performs:

Download the latest version of Free YouTube Downloader and install it. Launch the program.

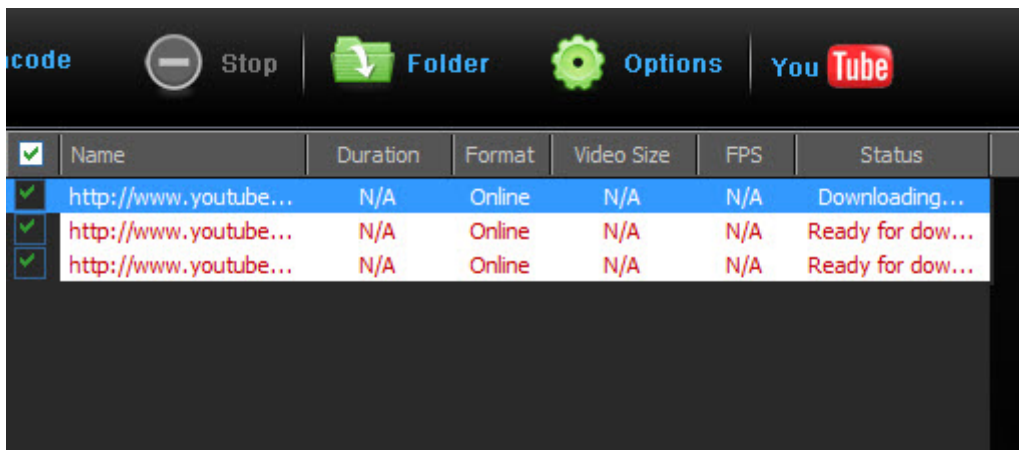


Visit youtube.com and open the YouTube videos you are going to download. Copy the URL of each video. You can get the URL of the video from the address bar of your browser.

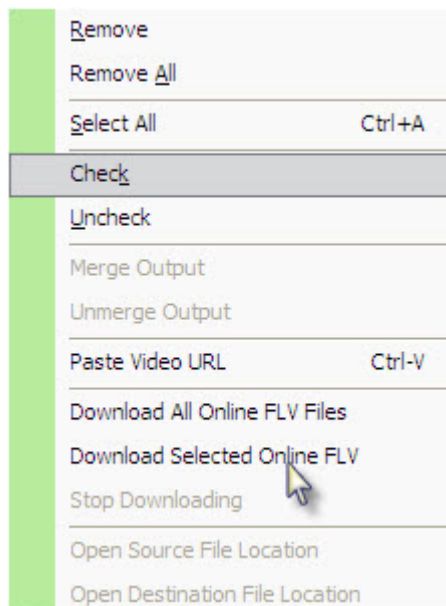
Click the "YouTube" button in the main interface of Free YouTube Downloader. In the pop up dialog of "Import Video from Internet", paste the URL of the YouTube video you copied just now.



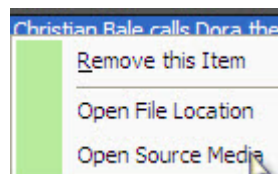
There will be a list of the added YouTube videos.



Tick the videos you are going to download. Right click any of the added video and choose "Download Selected Online FLV" from the drop-down list.

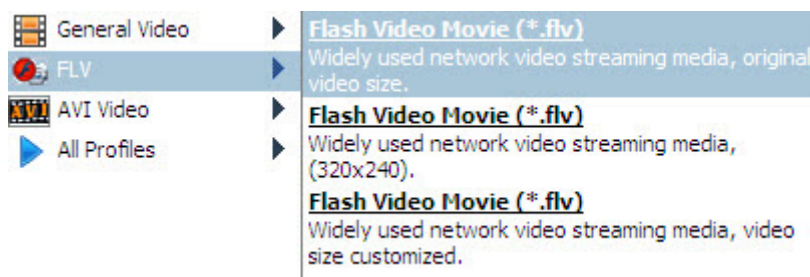


The downloading status is clearly shown on the list. After the status of all of them indicates "Completed", you can get the downloaded .flv videos by right clicking the video list and clicking "Open Source Media" from the drop-down list.



Alternatively, you can click the "Folder" in the main interface to get the output folder.

Plus, if you want to download the YouTube videos as video formats other than FLV, you just need a further step. Click the downward arrow from "Profile" panel and choose a specific format (in the free version of Clone2Go Video Converter Professional <http://www.clone2go.com/products/videoconverter.php> , you can only choose AVI, FLV or MPG as the output video format).



Part 2. How to transfer YouTube videos to iPod/PSP/Zune/BlackBerry

If you want to transfer the downloaded YouTube videos to iPod touch, iPod nano, iPod classic, iPod video, you can get Clone2Go Video to iPod Converter to help you convert the FLV videos to the video format your iPod supports. Then you can watch the YouTube videos on your iPod.

If you want to transfer the downloaded YouTube videos to BlackBerry Storm, BlackBerry Curve, BlackBerry Pearl, you can get Clone2Go Video to BlackBerry Converter to help you convert the FLV videos to the video format your BlackBerry supports. Then you can watch the YouTube videos on your BlackBerry.

If you want to transfer the downloaded YouTube videos to Zune, you can get Clone2Go Video to Zune Converter to help you convert the FLV videos to the video format your Zune supports. Then you can watch the YouTube videos on your Zune.

If you want to transfer the downloaded YouTube videos to PSP, you can get Clone2Go Video to PSP Converter to help you convert the FLV videos to the video format your PSP supports. Then you can watch the YouTube videos on your PSP.
