

## How to convert AVI MKV WMV ASF 3GP RM RMVB FLV to iPod/iPhone/Zune/PSP?

The following step by step guide shows you how to convert AVI, MKV, WMV, ASF, 3GP, RM, RMVB, FLV, etc. to video/audio file for iPod, iPhone, Zune, PSP, BlackBerry and other mobile players.

What you will need is [Clone2Go DVD Ripper](#) or [Video Converter Pro](#). In this guide, I'd like to show the steps using Video Converter Pro.

**Step 1.** Run Clone2Go Video Converter Pro. Click the "Add Video" button to import the video files you are going to convert. Alternatively, you can click "File -> Add Video Files..." to load the video files. The supporting video/audio formats include:

Audio Files (\*.mp2, \*.mp3, \*.wav)

Windows Media Files (\*.avi, \*.wmv, \*.asf, \*.dvr-ms, \*.ms-dvr)

MOV/MP4 Files (\*.mov, \*.mp4, \*.3gp, \*.m4v, \*.qt)

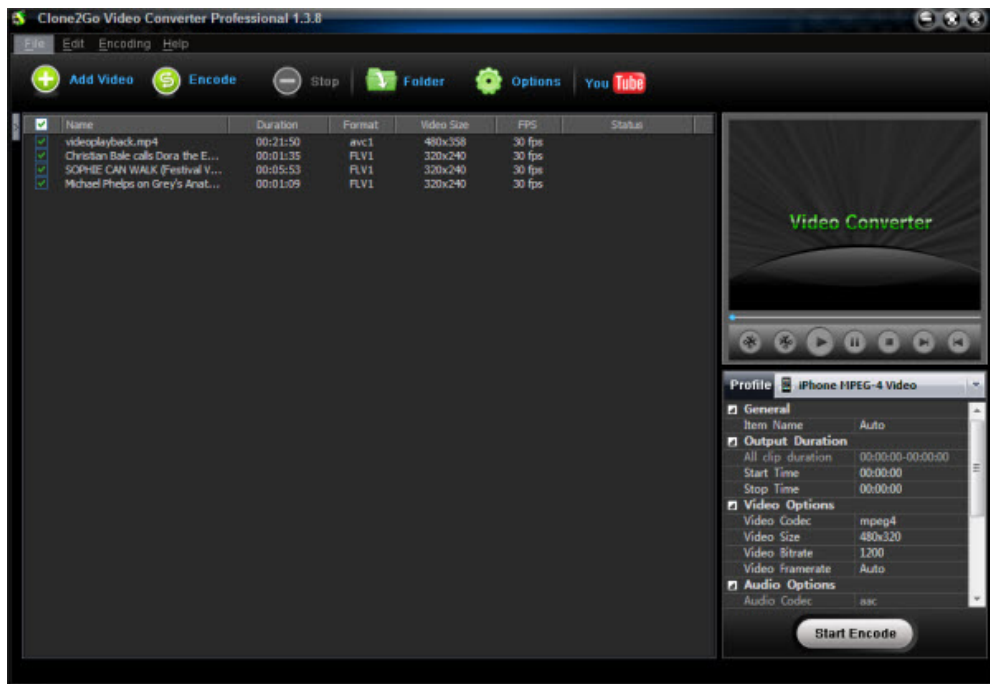
Real Media Files (\*.rm, \*.rmvb)

Flash Video Files (\*.flv)

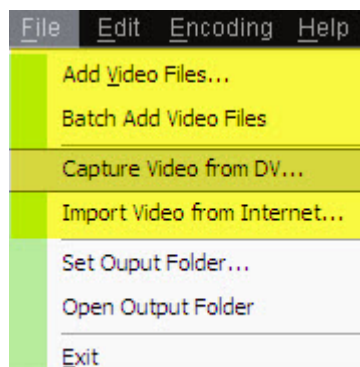
MKV Video Files (\*.mkv)

AviSynth Scripts (\*.avs)

Other Video Files (\*.mpg, \*.vob, \*.dv, \*.m1v, \*.m2v, \*.dat, \*.amv)



**Note:** This video converter also allows you to **batch add video files**, **capture video from DV** as video source and even **import online videos**.



**Step 2.** Extend the "Profile" category to select an output format according to your mobile device. For example, if you want to convert video files for your iPhone, you can choose "iPhone MPEG-4" as the output format.

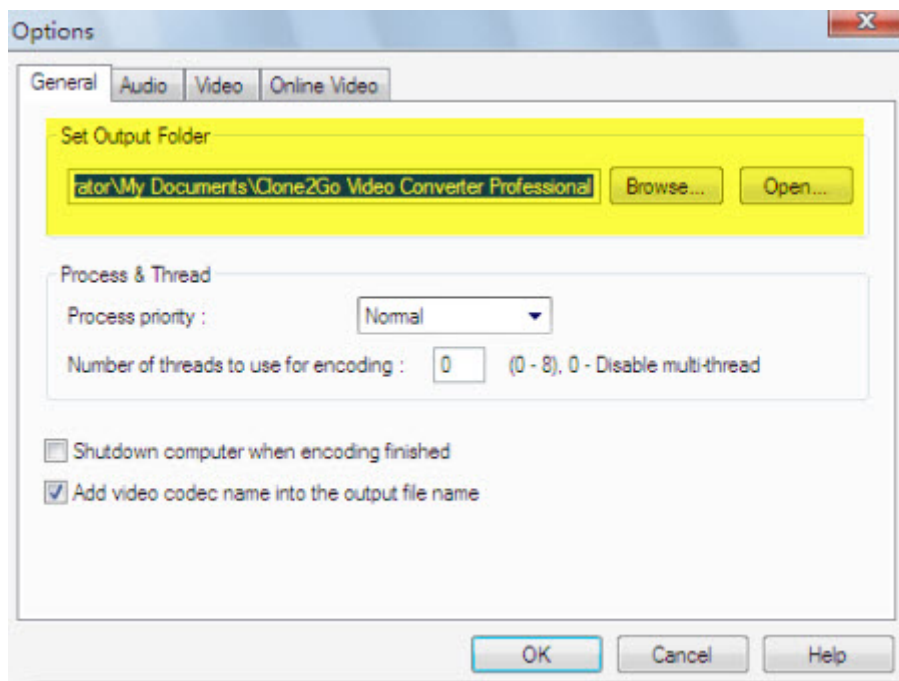


From the profile category, we know that, apart from general AVI, MP4, WMV, FLV, 3GP formats, Clone2Go Video Converter Pro can also help to convert video to specific format for iPod, iPhone, BlackBerry, Apple TV, Nokia, PSP, PS3, Zune, Mobile Phone, Creative Zen, Archos, Pocket PC, Xbox, etc.

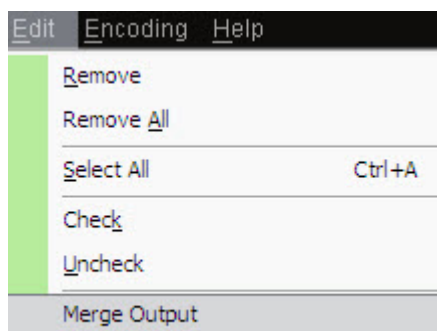
If you want to **customize the output video**, you can click the "Video Options" and "Audio Options" buttons below the "Profile" category. There you can set video resolution, frame rate, bit rate, video codec, etc.

**Step 3.** Specify the output folder. Click the "Options" button on the main interface. In the "General" tab, you can specify the folder for the output file. For your convenience, the output file is easily available by clicking the "Folder" button in the main interface after the encoding process.



To combine several video files into one file, multi-select the videos showing in the program. Click "Edit" and select "Merge Output". The selected videos will be merged into one file after the conversion.



**Step 4.** After all the steps above, click the "Start Encode" button to start to convert AVI, MKV, WMV, ASF, 3GP, RM, RMVB, FLV, etc. to video/audio format for iPod, iPhone, Zune, PSP, BlackBerry, etc.
